Report of the Program

The Induction program for all the students of I year B.Tech admitted into the college in the year 2019 has been conducted from 19th to 31st of August 2019 as per the guidelines of the AICTE/UGC.

An orientation program was conducted for all the students and parents on 17th and 18th August 2019 for ECE & CSE and EEE, ME & CE respectively. The above mentioned activities were split into two groups – the 1st group, which includes, Creative Arts, Human Values / Personality Development, Essence of Engineering, Literary Activities, Awareness on Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship, Local Area Visit / Service Activities, Visit to common facilities and students' clubs and closing phase, and the 2nd group includes Proficiency modules, Open Educational Resources, Principal's presentation, Gender sensitization, and

Department visit. Proficiency Modules include teaching basics of Mathematics, English & Communication Skills and Computer awareness for all the students. A book titled 'Yashasweebhava', authored by *Dr.KVSG Muralikrishna* has been distributed to each of the students.

Activities of the 1st group were conducted for 5 days in the first week of the program i.e. 19–24 August (23rd August was a holiday on account of Sri Krishnastami) and those of 2nd group for 5 days in the second week i.e 26-31 August 2019 (29th August was a holiday on account of bundh called by some students' unions). Physical activity, which include sports, games, yoga and meditation, was conducted for both the weeks. Detailed schedule of all these activities is given in Appendix-2.


While committees constituted for each of these activities made necessary arrangements like planning and preparing program schedules, identifying resource persons, hospitality of resource persons etc., Heads of departments were entrusted with the responsibility of putting in place Public Address System, one Technician and one helper at each of the venues used for conducting these activities. Dr. Y.V.Mohan Reddy, Head of the Basic Sciences department has designed the program for the 2nd week (Proficiency modules and a few other activities) and also took care of transportation arrangements, attendance monitoring and general discipline among students during entire program. Dr.R.Praveensam, Co-convenor of this program, looked after all the financial transactions. Dr.G.Raghuram, PRO, made general arrangements like accommodation for guests / resource persons, Banners, Mementos, Sweet boxes, Public address systems. Lunch, Snacks and Tea was arranged to all the guests and organizing committee members at Food court, which was monitored by the PRO.

Reports submitted by the conveners of individual activities are enclosed. Also enclosed are schedules of different events, the list of organizing committee, feedback given by the students, and the summary of expenditure.

The total expenditure incurred for this program is **Rs. 450990** (Rupees Four lacs fifty thousand nine hundred and ninety only).

Remarks / Suggestions:

- Total expenditure for this event in this year (Rs. 450990) is less compared to the previous year (Rs. 557007). This is primarily due to optimal utilization of resource persons by combining the students of different branches for some activities like Human Values/Personality Development, Local area visit, and Creative Arts.
- Faculty in charge of Physical activity opined that he didn't receive whole-hearted cooperation from other members of his committee. He is advised to allot duties to individual members specifically and take their signatures to make them accountable.
